Born and bred in Bordeaux, Renan Theilloux's passion for winemaking was inspired by his French grandmother, a wine connoisseur who taught him how to appreciate good wine. As a teenager, Renan schooled his palate by winning horse riding competitions where top prizes often earned him quality bottles of wine. Graduating with a winemaking degree from the University of Toulouse, Renan worked on a small 25ha winery in Bordeaux where he was completely hands-on in production.

In a time of economic uncertainty for French winemakers, Renan became one of a new breed of fly-in winemakers, travelling and working in iconic wineries like Flowers and Sonoma Cutrer in the US and Hawkes Bay and Marlborough in New Zealand. The award-winning Sileni Estates, acclaimed Kim Crawford Wines and Indevin New Zealand, a stateof-the-art custom crush winery, providing valuable experience for the artisan winemaker.

After a stint back in France, working in sales and later as a winemaker for the Ducourt family vineyard in Bordeaux, Renan decided to make a permanent move to the southern hemisphere.

Settling in Central Otago, a top 5 new world wine producing regions, he worked for 5 years as a winemaker for Alexandra Vintners, a contract winery producing premium wine for their clients.
